Information for Parents and Carers



What happens if my child doesn't wear the correct uniform?

At Brightstowe, we believe that the way we present ourselves plays a huge part in our success and makes us professional in our appearance and attitude.

That is why we insist on the highest standards in our students' uniform.

We appreciate your support in abiding by this important part of our School Ethos.

Students who don't conform to our high expectations will either need to return home to change or will be given the option to borrow missing items. Should they refuse, we will contact parents to support us to resolve the issue in a timely manner.

However, there may be exceptional circumstance where your child is unable to be in the correct uniform. If you find yourself in this position you should contact your child's Head of Year by telephone, or by writing a note, and let them know what the problem is and when we can expect to see them again in the Academy Uniform.

Their Head of Year may then write a note for your child to carry with them so that, when challenged about their uniform, they are able to show the note to other staff.

If, for any medical reason, your child is unable to wear an item of uniform, you should make contact with their Head of Year who will discuss suitable alternatives with you.

School Shoes

Shoes should be smart, and plain black, with no branding or colourful accessories. Trainers can only be worn during PE lessons.



All students who attend Oasis Academy Brightstowe are required to wear the correct uniform at all times. The Academy uniform is a black blazer with the Academy badge and sleeves must not be rolled up.
